Jewish Hospital Medical Center South, Brooks, KY

Scope: Comprehensive Commissioning for new construction of medical facilities consisting of a 49,000 square foot medical center and a 24,000 square foot medical office building, offering a wide range of outpatient services in a convenient and comfortable setting. This building has obtained LEED Silver certification.

Scope: Comprehensive HVAC Commissioning for new construction of training center building for field officer's billet, enlisted men's barracks, multi-purpose classroom building, and a dining facility.
