THERMOGRAPHY EXPERIENCE

Kenton County Schools – Twenhofel Middle School, Independence, KY

Project Cost: \$19,000,000.00 / 112,000 square feet

Scope: This new school accommodates 900 students and was constructed to replace the existing Twenhofel Middle School. The new school has three academic wings with a fourteen-foot wide mall corridor separating the library, gymnasium, and commons area, which will allow these areas to function independently from the academic areas during and after school hours. This building has been designed for utility efficiency. The majority of the spaces are naturally day lit by a unique building section consisting of roof dormers with a band of glass to allow natural light from above to illuminate the rooms.

Fort Campbell – Soldier’s Family Assistance Center, Fort Campbell, KY

Project Cost: \$5,000,000.00 / 15,000 square feet

Scope: This new facility of office suites, event hall, lobby area, connected outdoor shelter area and child activity center to provide consolidated services for wounded Soldiers and Families as they transition either back to duty or to civilian life.

Fort Campbell – Unit Ops CID COF, Fort Campbell, KY

Project Cost: \$5,000,000.00 / 12,569 square feet (additional space)

Scope: This project consisted of renovating an existing Criminal Investigation Division (CID) facility Bldg. 2745, and the construction of a new CID COF immediately adjacent to that existing building. Renovation of Bldg. 2745 will be minimal and will only affect a small portion of the total interior (13,249 gross sf) and a small amount of site improvements were provided to meet the mission of the 31st MP Detachment (Det) CID. New construction will consist of the 5th MP BN (CID) and new MP Det CID buildings.
